

BRUCE TURNER

Turner, a Director of Lottomatica since August 2006, previously served as President and CEO of GTECH Corporation from 2001 through April 2007, and CEO from May through December 2007, at which time he retired from the company.

During his tenure, GTECH experienced significant growth: total revenues grew 34 percent; earnings per share rose three-fold, or 200 percent; and the Company's lottery customer base expanded by 11 percent.

For the 10-year period from 1989 to 1999, Turner worked on Wall Street with two firms and was widely recognized as the premier equity analyst in the gaming and leisure industry. *Institutional Investor* magazine repeatedly ranked him as the finest global analyst in the gaming field, and *Gaming and Wagering Business* magazine ranked him as one of the "25 most powerful people in the gaming industry." Turner, a graduate of the United States Military Academy at West Point (New York), received his Master of Arts in Management and Supervision from Central Michigan University, and a Master of Business Administration from the University of Tampa in Florida.

He was also awarded an honorary Doctorate of Business Administration from Roger Williams University in Rhode Island.
